We had a well attended workshop and gallery tour, for year 12 and 13 art and photography students who had the opportunity to discuss their proposal and presentation for the competition - Volunteer students are preparing a 10 minutes verbal and visual presentation about an artwork of their choice- The students will present during our internal college heat-hub in February- One student will be selected by our panel to enter the regional semi-final in Roche Court in March, during which one student out of all regional schools will be chosen for the grand final, a national competition held at the National Gallery [Online if needed]. Participants enjoyed an informal chat with the Rochecourt team and thereafter were offered the opportunity to speak about their chosen artwork over a one minute timed presentation. They received advice on how to improve and further develop to increase their impact and how the themes invite them into an individual perspective. The Rochecourt team was impressed by the student's level of proposal and look forward to supporting them further in this adventure.
