do assignments as soon as they are set

ask your teachers to mark anything extra you've done or if they've got more stuff for you to do as a levels are heavy subjects

work less and if you have a free day from college do some studying but not the entire time as you need time for yourselves too

create flashcards/mind maps/revision materials after each lesson to make future revision easier

there is no excuse for you not to do work and assignments. if you want a good grade you earn it with hard work and revision. watching educational vids and asking for help

don't spend all summer worrying about your GCSEs!! There's so many options and paths to go down if something goes wrong

keep up with the classwork so that you don't fall behind and become stressed.

Don't keep going to Mcdonald's, B&M or Home Bargains during independent study when you have assignments due.

Make sure you are well organised

don't be scared to get to know people you haven't met before.

make sure you are aware of how you are going to be assessed, e.g., is there coursework you have to complete or is it all exam based

don't take things too seriously no need to stress as long as you get your work done and take time for yourself

you may hate college for the first few weeks or term... it gets better

its not the end of the world if you get a bad grade in a data capture its just a test, you have time to learn from it and get the grade up.

Make sure you go to open days!! They help. Make sure you're 100% with the choices you make

dont always use free periods to meet friends, you will regret it
