## LIFE SKILLS

Students will attend Life Skills
sessions with their tutor
every other week and year
group assemblies every
fortnight. In tutor sessions
students will use Unifrog to
explore careers themes linking
to the careers programme.

# 1:1 CAREERS GUIDANCE

All students are entitled to careers guidance which can be requested at any time, especially when career choices are being made.

Careers guidance is with a level 6 qualified careers adviser.

## CAREERS IN THE CURRICULUM

Students will hear about careers related to the subjects they are studying.
Students will have employer encounters through the curriculum.

#### WORK EXPERIENCE

All students are expected to complete at least 3 days work experience in Year 12. Students must arrange their own placement and log it on Unifrog.

#### APPRENTICESHIPS FAIR

Around National
Apprenticeships Week all
students will attend an
apprenticeships fair and
hear about apprenticeships
from employers and
training providers.

#### UNIVERSITY FAIR

All students will attend a
UCAS Fair at a local university
where they can speak to
university representatives
from across the country and
ask questions about the
courses they offer.

## APPLICATIONS SUPPORT

Students will hear from employers and universities about what they look for in applications and recruitment processes as well as personal statements.

Workshops include personal statement checking and mock interviews as well as student finance applications.
