Course Description

Creative Media Practice is a vocational media and filmmaking course. The entire course is coursework based so there are no external exams.

The course is designed for students who are keen to learn the digital media production techniques that are used to make professional films and television programmes. The course is accepted by UCAS so will help you gain entry to university, if that is the destination you are planning.

You will learn the fundamentals of filmmaking such as screenwriting, editing, composition, camera operation, special effects and much, much more. Whilst we have some DSLR cameras you can hire out it is recommended that you have your own camera. We edit on the professional non-linear editing program Davinci Resolve and it is recommended that you also download this software (a free version is available).
