Remember, this is optional but it would be really cool if you could give it a go. There are TONS of DaVinci Resolve tutorials online to help you too.

Here are some good YouTube video essays on some filmmaking 101 techniques:

- Basic Shot Types
- Over the shoulder shots
- Close-ups and wide shots
- The 180 Degree Rule essential!
- Rule of Thirds
