Course Description

The Extended Project Qualification is worth the equivalent of half an A Level and can be taken as an optional extra in addition to your full programme of study. You will develop high level research skills in developing a project on a topic of your choice, which could be in the form of an extended piece of writing, artefact, production or digital piece of work. You will be required to give a short presentation on your project as part of the assessment.

This qualification is valued by universities and gives you the opportunity to boost your application, either with extra UCAS points or with a proven ability to work independently and academically. It can also be used to showcase interest in an area relevant to a career or higher level study and this can be discussed in detail in future applications.
