These documents were prepared to ensure a rigorous approach was taken to ascertain a Centre Assessed Grade and ranking for each student that is fair and representative.

If for any reason you feel that the result you have received is significantly different to what you are expecting, please contact the College. Firstly discuss the grade with a member of the SLT, if further investigation is required an Exam Grade Query will be raised with Lisa Lucas, Examinations Officer: [llucas@salisbury6c.ac.uk](mailto:llucas@salisbury6c.ac.uk). The request will need to include the exact details of your query including the subject and grade.

There is no appeal process this year for students. The college will be comparing the grades awarded by the examining bodies to the CAG grades we submitted. If there appears to be a clerical error and a discrepancy between the two, then the college will act and notify the examining body and query the result. If the awarding grades are broadly in line with some adjustments made to the CAG grades, then the college will not have the ability to challenge these and the grades will stand.

There will be an Autumn Exam Season for all A levels, this will take place in October. Please contact the college if this is an option you would like to discuss further.
