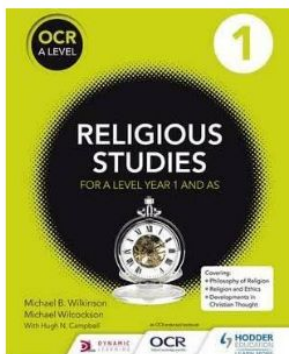


RS, Philosophy and Ethics Summer Induction Work
