

S6C Learner Agreement

Under this agreement, S6C will endeavour to provide:

- A curriculum that matches your interests and aspirations and is delivered by suitably qualified members of staff using high quality facilities and resources
- Regular setting and marking of work with constructive feedback on how to improve
- Support in developing effective study skills
- A friendly caring and supportive environments in which to study and work
- Regular discussions on your progress with your tutor, providing guidance and assistance in setting targets for improvement
- Impartial advice on careers, employment, welfare, finance, spiritual and pastoral care issues
- Help in applying to university and progression from college
- Advice and guidance on your personal health and wellbeing including coping with stress
- The opportunity to take part in varied Clubs and Societies, including opportunities to be part of the S6C Student Union
- Regular progress reviews and the opportunity for your parents to come into the College to discuss your progress
- A forum for expressing your views and contributing to the development of Salisbury 6th Form College

As a student of S6C:

- I accept that I must attend fully and complete all aspects of my College Programme (including English or Maths GCSE if I have not achieved a Grade 4). These are:
- Academic/technical subjects
- Independent study
- Tutorial and tutor 1:1s and the Life Skills Programme (as well as our 3 Development Days)
- Clubs and Societies (a member of at least one across the college year)







- I accept my attendance level should be 100% and needs to be in excess of 92% if I am likely to achieve my potential.
- I accept that if my attendance falls below 90% for any course or other part of my programme I will be subject to being placed on contract to be monitored closely. This will normally be for up to 3 weeks where it will either end or be escalated for continued monitoring.
- If I am absent for 4 weeks the college has the right to take me off roll.
- I accept that I need to complete and submit to deadline all work set outside of class or I will be subject to being monitored on contract. I may be asked to leave the college if my efforts are not remedied.
- I accept that my courses will be provided based on a 50:50 curriculum, which means that I need to spend at least 50% of my college time on Independent Study and the college will provide 50% of my college time in taught sessions. Any part time employment or other commitments I have should not impact negatively on my studies or reduce my Independent Study time.
- I will use my time productively in college in my allocated Independent Study and fully commit to improving and developing my work.
- I will register for UCAS and if I intend on going to university I will complete the application in plenty of time for my tutor to complete a reference. If I do not plan on going to university then I will ensure I have a suitable progression plan for leaving college, such as an Apprenticeship or employment.
- I accept that I must download all of the Google for Education Apps to my devices and that I must have a suitable device for my classes.

We do recommend that you look into your home insurance policy to make sure the laptop is covered while at College. If not, it's advisable to look into insurance cover, as losing access to college work for a period of time can be very detrimental to final grades. All liability for damage to a BYOD belongs to the student and they are responsible for making sure they can access college systems.
