Principal's Message

It has been another busy week here at S6C, as you will see from this newsletter. Susan Pollack's testimony about her experience of Auschwitz– Birkenau and Bergen-Belsen provided an important context for the Holocaust Memorial Day. Her experience resonated with me because my father was a young army officer who went into Bergen-Belsen to help liberate the camp. Our students were fascinated about what she had to say and as you would expect behaved impeccably.

Holocaust Memorial Day



As mentioned in our previous newsletter, on Friday 24th January, our students had the privilege to join a Webcast via the Holocaust Educational Trust, and hear from Susan Pollack MBE, a Holocaust Survivor. Susan shared with students her experiences and testimony to mark the Holocaust Memorial Day 2020, and 75 years since the liberation of Auschwitz-Birkenau. The college is also sending 2 students to Auschwitz again in March this year, as part of the Lessons from Auschwitz Project. So far we have sent 2-4 teachers and a member of staff each year since we opened in 2014.

Art students have visited the Winchester School of Art to work with artist Sharon Harvey. They were able to work in a professional art space to gain a sense of what it's like to be a professional artist. They have also visited various galleries in and around Salisbury. Whilst at the Winchester School of Art, Sharon Harvey painted them at work.
