The "Mid Year Review" for our year 13 students was planned to help students with motivation and support for the upcoming exam season. The day was separated into a introduction from Richard Eno and then two workshops on exam revision techniques and then "How to Reduce Stress and Increase Wellbeing". The students then had two subject sessions, which were mostly run like seminars where students were in small groups with their teachers to discuss areas of improvement, identifying gaps in knowledge. It was a really positive day and many students commented that they felt better prepared for the challenges ahead.

Every year we run a trip for all of our year 12 students to explore options for university, apprenticeships and employment after S6C. This year, students will be taken to the official UCAS fair at Winchester University in the summer term.
