### Y12 Summer Assessment Week

The Year 12 end of year assessments will take place the week starting 21 June and will finish on 2 July. The Photography assessment will take place all day on Friday 25 June and the Art assessment will take place all day on Friday 2 July. All A Level written subjects will sit 1 paper and students will be prepared for these by their class teachers. Students studying Business BTEC, Sport Technical Diploma, Health and Social Care, Applied Law and Applied Science will have a written assessment and are included on the timetable. There will be no taught classes for any year 12 this week, with the exception of Computer Science and Creative Media, all lessons for these subjects should be attended.

There will be activities and assignments set on Classroom throughout the assessment week, which students will be expected to access and complete.

All assessments will be held in the Hall or in the Dance Studio. Our additional COVID cleaning processes will continue as normal. The JCQ guidelines for conducting examinations will be followed to give students the opportunity of having an experience close to sitting exams in full exam conditions.

A learning point for us from our experience of the process leading up to final grades earlier this year is the importance of gathering data required to provide Teacher Assessed Grades. It is imperative that grades provided best reflect students' ability and the evidence needs to be reliable and robust. A major component of this is internal assessments in exam conditions, should we be required to follow a similar process next summer we will be well prepared. This will also enable students and their teachers to have a clear view on their strengths and areas for development and improvement, to assist this, marked papers will be returned with detailed feedback.

The study centre will be open all week for students to study and we encourage students to utilise this space if this makes studying easier as an alternative to home.

Monday 28th June is a College inset day, and Tuesday 29th June is Fresher Day for the new Y12, this will be a Reading Day for current Y12 not involved with Fresher Day. Normal timetable will resume on Wednesday 30th June, with the exception of the Art assessments which will be taking place on Friday in the Art Studio.

### Students

- You will need to bring standard exam materials in a clear pencil case or clear plastic bag. These should include equipment needed for your exam; pens, pencils, rubber, maths materials and calculators where needed. Water is allowed in a clear bottle with no label; no food is allowed in the assessments.

- You must not bring bags, mobile phones or any watches to the examination room. Please ensure you are gathered outside the hall, 15 minutes before the assessment is due to start for a pre-assessment briefing. Exam conditions will apply throughout these mocks, the experience will help to prepare you for what to expect in the Summer Season 2022.

For those students with access arrangements in place, all necessary adjustments will be arranged including extra time, provision of laptops, rest breaks and coloured paper. The duration of assessments will be extended to allow for extra time where appropriate. Assessments will be as per the main timetable and will take place in the dance studio or the project room (RS).

Apologies for those of you who have little time for a break between assessments, this is a busy week and there is no other way to fit every assessment into the week.
