

## Year 12 Exam Resits

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Our students have had a busy year adapting to the rigours of studying level 3 qualifications. Throughout year 12 our students were assessed and their progress monitored. The final data capture has been marked and you should have received the report, which came home with the students this week.

Many of the students have performed well, demonstrating the skills and work ethic necessary to be successful in their level 3 qualifications next year. For some students in specific subjects they have not achieved the grade to achieve automatic entry into year 13 in that subject. If you have received this letter your young person has achieved an E or U grade in one or more of their subjects.

We understand that underperformance can occur for a variety of reasons. To help students make progress and avoid disappointment at the end of year 13 we will be asking students with U or E grades to resit a paper on Tuesday 3rd September, which is the first day back after the summer holidays for year 13.

The relevant subject teacher will set summer work to help support your young person in developing their knowledge and skills ready for the resit exams.

The resits will be held on Tuesday 3rd September. The details of timings and locations will be posted on the Google student information classroom. The work will be marked as quickly as possible and if we have additional concerns about progress in that subject we will consult with you and your young person to decide on an appropriate course of action.
